

Sports premium funding grant 2025-26: £19,560

All grant money has been spent as detailed below:

CPD internal learning and development £750

Impact: Increased knowledge and confidence in delivering PE lessons and becoming involved in extracurricular activities. All sporting clubs full this year.

Spend on CPD external coaches supporting confidence and competence £ 9750

Impact: Children have had access to high quality sports provision resulting in increased involvement and enjoyment of physical movement.

Total school spending on CPD £10,500

Internal school based extra-curricular opportunities £1850

Impact: All children have had access to a wide range of sporting activities and opportunities – take up of clubs has increased. This is important in an area where sporting resource is very limited. (Football, hockey, golf, dodgeball, gymnastics, swimming)

Internal sports competitions £550

Impact: Number of children taking part in competitions such as football tournaments have increased. There is both girls and boys football competitions.

Internal top up-swimming lessons and broadening aquatic opportunities for pupils £1200

Impact: Fewer children are non-swimmers by the time they reached year 6. (60% swimmers in year 6, 30% can perform a range of strokes) This is an essential skill where access to a swimming pool is limited yet there are water hazards very locally eg reservoir.

Internal active travel £980

Impact: Children have been able to attend more events and competitions (fixtures, district sports etc) and have an increased understanding and appreciation of attending sporting events.

Internal equipment and resources £1570

Impact: Children have access to quality, fit for purpose equipment which enables them to hone their skills more effectively. Eg football goals and balls, basketball hoops and balls, tennis rackets, track equipment, skipping ropes.

Internal membership fees £360

Impact: Children have access to competitions such as District sports where they achieved 4th place out of seven and came home with a range of gold, silver and bronze medals.

Total spend on internal activities £6550

Inter-school sports competitions £500

Impact: Children are able to compete with a wider range of children and learn the importance of sportsmanship, resilience and school representation. In addition, those children who have never represented the school played in a tournament specifically for them.

External coaching staff £2000

Impact: Children have access to specialist provision not easily available in the area eg football, hockey, dodgeball, golf, sailing and cycling
